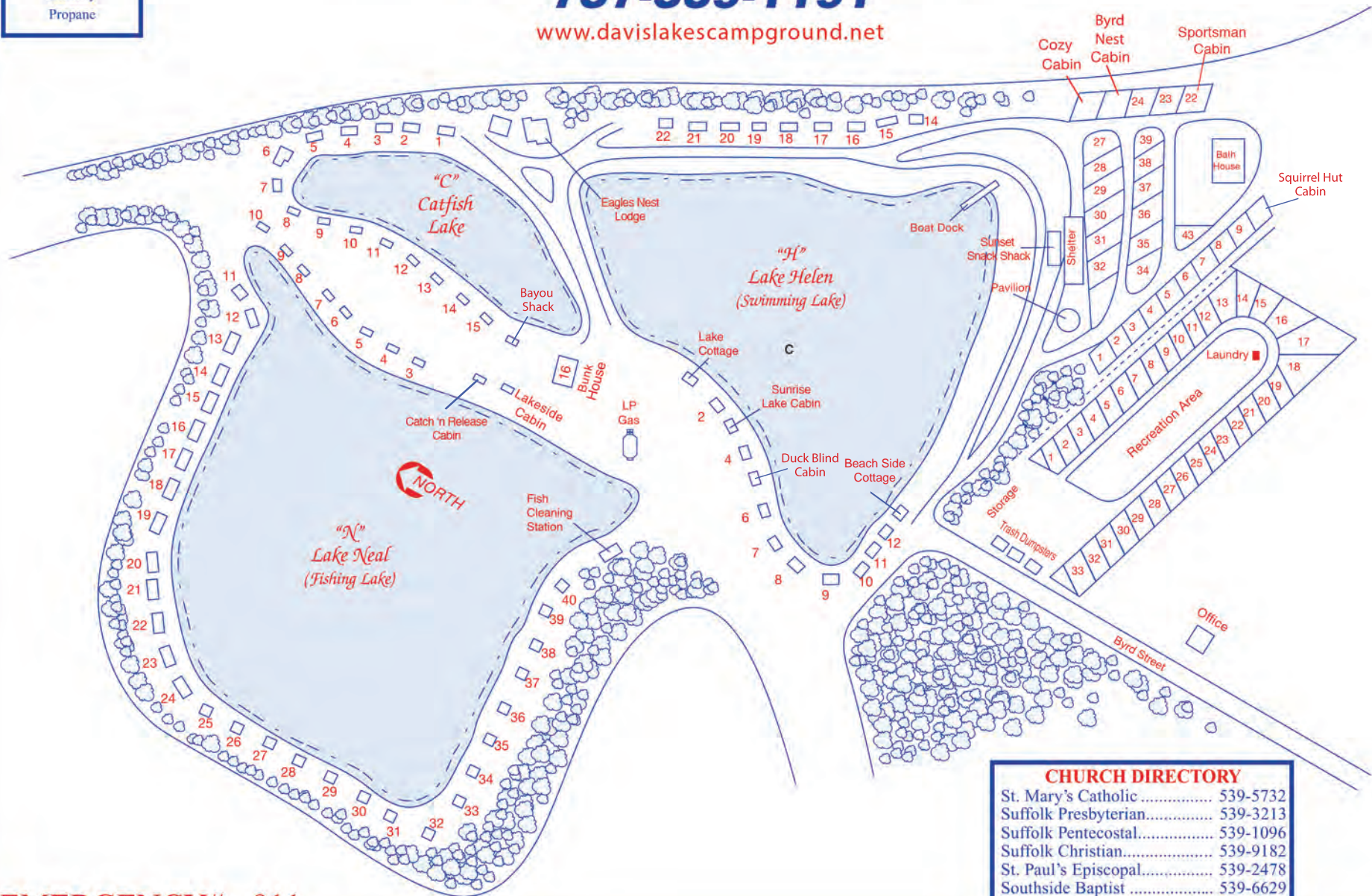

DAVIS LAKES CAMPGROUND RULES

Dear Campers,

Hopefully these rules will be clear; if not, PLEASE feel free to ask for clarification.

Check out time: 11:00 a.m.

- ALL PETS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES. PET DROPPINGS MUST BE CLEANED UP IMMEDIATELY. Keep pets quiet. Do not leave pets UNATTENDED at campsite. Pets are not allowed on the BEACH.**
- Please notify the office if you are expecting visitors. All visitors will be charged \$3.00 for children and \$5.00 for adults. Visitors will not be allowed on site if office is not notified. Visitors are not allowed to bring pets.**
- Washing cars or RV's is prohibited.
- Two vehicles per lot, check with office for additional parking.
- Electric golf carts only. Golf carts must be insured.
- No speeding, if caught speeding you will be removed from park.
- Do not park on the grass, stay on the gravel. Please do not park on a site you are not renting. Place carpets on gravel only, not on grass.
- Do not walk or ride bikes through sites you are not renting.
- Absolutely NO DIGGING or DRIVING anything into the ground.
- Do not leave campfires unattended. Keep fires small. Do not burn trash.
- Sewer lines from your RV should be no more than four (4) inches inside our sewer pipe. All sewer lines must be sealed - Virginia State Law! Holding tanks must be kept closed until they are at least half full, then make sure you close it back after dumping. If we find tanks open we will close them. **No washing machine use is allowed.**
- Do not permit water to drip inside or outside trailer.
- One (1) table per site. Please do not move tables. Do not cook on tables.
- Quiet time is from 11 PM to 7 AM. Outside radios and TV's are to be turned off at 11 PM.
- No public display of alcoholic beverages on campground.
- No lethal weapons allowed on campground.
- Unlicensed motorcycles, 3 & 4 wheelers are not allowed. Absolutely no loud vehicles allowed.
- Swimming is allowed on designated beach only. Children 12 and under must be accompanied and watched responsible adult at all times. No person or inflatable objects on or outside of ropes. No swimming from dusk to dawn. Never swim alone. Please read and abide by beach rules beside steps above beach.
- Parents must know where and what their children are doing at all times. Parents are fully responsible for their safety and actions. Children and teens must be at their site by 10 PM.
- The management reserves the right to evict immediately, without refund, any persons violating any of these rules. Anyone using profane language, becoming intoxicated or conducting themselves in such a manner that would disturb or cause danger to others will also be evicted immediately.
- This property being privately owned, the guest accepts campground privileges with the understanding that he/she does hereby release the campground, its officers and employees of all liability for loss or damage to property and injury to his/her person arising out of his/her use of campground facilities and agrees to indemnify the campground, its officers and employees against claims resulting from loss or damage to property or injury to the person or any member of the family or guests arising out of the use of its' campground facilities.
